SOUTHEASTERN VT COMMUNITY ACTION PROGRAMS

Family Services: Comprehensive support services and assistance to help individuals and families. Assistance includes housing stabilization and case management, fuel assistance, crisis resolution, 3Squares VT outreach and, advocacy / application assistance, and community resource navigation.

Emergency Home Repair: Minor repairs that address energy-related, building integrity, and health & safety issues.

<u>Weatherization</u>: Reduce utility/heating costs and stay warm in winter, cool in summer. Home energy audits, heating system repair / replacement, appliance replacement, and energy conservation improvements such as insulation and sealing holes.

Micro Business Development: Staff support and guide individuals with technical assistance for start-up and expansion of small businesses including business plans, financial documents, ongoing support and more.



Financial Coaching: Free one-on-one financial coaching helps clients to develop money management skills, set financial goals, begin a savings plan, and improve financial stability.

<u>Volunteer Income Tax Assistance (VITA):</u>

Year-round tax services at little or no cost to qualifying Vermonters including Personal Income Tax Prep, Homestead Tax Credit, Property Tax Credit Claim, Renter Rebate Claim, and more. Head Start: A federally funded preschool program that is offered at no cost to qualifying families. We offer comprehensive services for children and families regarding health, nutrition, education, and parent engagement. Children and families are connected to: Medical & Dental Homes; Healthy Meals & Snacks; Services for Children & Families with disabilities; Services for non-English speaking families; Access to indoor and outdoor play in a safe environment; "Hands on" Curriculum, Learning through Play; Hearing & Vision Screens are also offered to enrolled children.
