We offer comprehensive services for children and families regarding health, nutrition, education, and parent engagement.

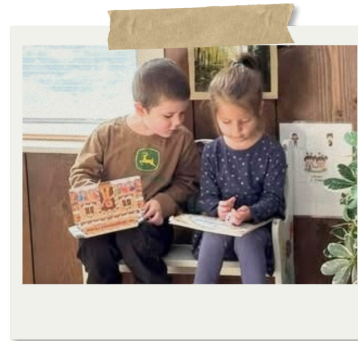
Children and families are connected to:

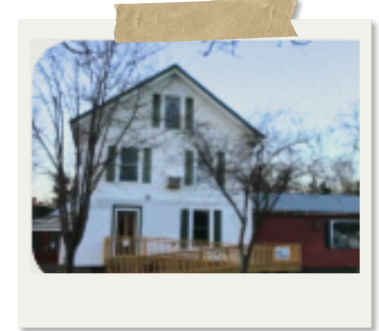
